

A.S. ROMA VS. VFB STUTTGART. ON GOING SECURITY PLANS COORDINATED BY THE ROME POLICE HEADQUARTERS. KEY POINTS: WELCOME TO AWAY SUPPORTERS AND MANDATORY RULES PURSUANT TO ITALIAN LAW AND THE CITY OF ROME.

We hereby inform that the tickets for away supporters to the Rome Olympic Stadium on the occasion of the football match A.S. Roma vs. VfB Stuttgart that will be held on January 22nd 2026 at 09.00 p.m. have already sold out.

The ongoing security plans coordinated by the Rome Police Headquarters, which will start the day before the match, involve strict measures like comprehensive risk assessment, highways checkpoints as well as patrolling both the city center and the nearby roads, habitually visited by the away and local supporters on the occasion of large international events.

Olympic stadium will be available for 3500 away supporters and the entrance into the stadium will not be allowed for any other German away supporters who intend to reach the City of Rome.

Anyone without a valid ticket will be denied entry even at the outside area which will be controlled by police officers.

The security plans involve the patrolling of the city center and all the other urban places usually visited by away supporters on the occasion of international matches.

Anti - riots teams will be set to be deployed on the field by the morning of January 21st, all over the city, even at night time.

Specific attention will be paid to the main airports and rail hubs, sensitive venues, and areas where pubs are located , attended by away supporters during their journey in Rome.

Rome Police Headquarters will do the best to welcome German supporters who want to enjoy the match with respect for the city of Rome and its monuments.

At the same time, any conduct against the Italian Law will be reproached. Specific Police Offices will be established to deal with troublesome supporters and ensuring police measures will be adopted against them even evaluating the deportation outside the italian borders.
